- ▶ Under the NLIS regulations, all cattle coming onto the show grounds MUST carry an approved NLIS device (ear tag or bolus). Cattle that do not have a NLIS device will be sent home.
- ▶ Section open to all breeds, to be judged as interbreed.
- ▶ ALL Floats/Trucks for Horses/Cattle must ONLY enter via GATE in NETTE STREET
- ▶ The age of cattle to be as 1 April, 2025. Date of birth to be shown on entry form.
- ▶ All cattle to be registered in the Herd Book or Calf Register of the Respective Breed Society.
- ▶ Each exhibitor is to state on the Entry Form, the number of classes intended to compete in and full particulars of each animal entered. Viz: Name in Full; Date of Birth; Colour; Sire and Dam; also Breeder's Name, Address and Email.
- ▶ All bovine over four (4) months must have appropriate nose grips and all bulls over 12 months must have a nose ring.
- ▶ All exhibitors or representatives MUST be in charge of their stock at all times.
- ▶ A sash will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize animals in each class.
- ▶ Exhibitors please note – Biggenden Show Grounds Brucellosis Stature – Accredited Free.
- ▶ Biggenden is in a Tick Area. Please be aware of your obligations if travelling.
- ▶ back to a Tick Free Area. Please contact an Accredited Certifier if Required.
- ▶ Any Calf shown on a cow is NOT eligible to be shown in any Individual class.
- ▶ Entry Form to be obtained from the Steward.

To be judged under QCAS rules (www.queenslandshows.com.au)

- ▶ Competitors under 15 can compete at the local level and Sub-Chamber Finals but are ineligible to compete at State Finals.
- ▶ Open to persons 15 years and under 25 years of age at 1st May.
- ▶ Competitors under 18 years must have approval of parent or guardian to attend and it is the responsibility of parents or guardians to make arrangements on behalf of the competitor.
- ▶ All competitors to be a resident in Queensland for at least three months prior to the competition or be attending a college in Queensland.
- ▶ Eligibility: National winners & persons on breed society senior judging panels are not eligible.
- ▶ A competitor may compete in any show and be awarded the sub-chamber final where they first won.
- ▶ A competitor can represent only one show society in any Sub-Chamber Final and only one sub-chamber in the State Finals.
- ▶ LOCAL SHOW COMMITTEES MAY ADJUST TO SUIT THEIR OWN SETTINGS.
- ▶ Details of the 2025 Sub-Chamber Regional Judging will be announced on the day.
